### Lessons in Lego

## In The Whole Wide World

### Traditional Rhyme

In this whole wide world (make a big circle with your arms)  
 I can clearly see (curve hands around eyes as though looking through binoculars)  
 There is only one of you (point to someone else)  
 And there is only one of me. (Point to yourself)

### NAME GAME

Have the children sit in a circle. Roll a ball to one of the children. When the ball comes to them, have them say their name. Once everyone has had a turn, repeat asking additional "get to know you" questions such as what is your favourite colour? do you have a pet? how old are you?...

### HANDPRINT SCIENCE

Using washable ink pads, have the children stamp their handprints onto paper. Talk about how each hand is unique and no two people make the same print. Allow the children a closer look by providing magnifying glasses to examine the neat little lines we make!

### FAMILY PHOTOS

Have each child bring in a picture of their family. Allow them the opportunity to share who is in their photo.
